We hope everyone continues to stay safe during the COVID-19 state of emergency. The Agency for Health Care Administration (Agency) would like to take this time to provide additional clarification on consents for school-based telemedicine services when the child is located on campus. Please find the attached Updated Medicaid School-Based Services Frequently Asked Questions (FAQs) Regarding Telemedicine Flexibilities for School Districts, Private, and Charter Schools During COVID-19. The update is highlighted in yellow under the "consent" section, as well as copy and pasted below:

When students are on campus receiving telemedicine services, is written consent required?

When a child is receiving services on campus, parents must have a choice and be informed regarding their options for face-to-face or telemedicine services. The option to opt in or out of the service using telemedicine should be made available. Schools should provide a reasonable deadline for parents to opt out of telemedicine services to ensure timeliness of service provision.
